




## CITADEL THEATRE CLUB 2017-18 SEASON




Dear Parents and Students,

We are so excited to be offering a great theatre experience to all our Junior High students and to be bringing students together across Stony Plain. The Citadel theater offers an amazing theatre experience for interested students. The Citadel's MacLab Students Club provides the opportunity for students to come together to enjoy six amazing evening performances throughout the year. Students will receive a light supper, participate in a talk back session with some of Edmonton's professional theatre members, and attend six mainstage productions at the Citadel Theatre.

On the date of each play, High Park students are asked to stay after school as the bus will be leaving High Park at 4:20pm and Meridian Heights students are asked to be at High Park for this scheduled time. We will then proceed to Stony Plain Central to pick up students at 4:35 pm. Please ensure that students have a substantial afterschool snack and a bottle of water. We anticipate returning to Stony Plain by approximately 10:30 pm. Meridian Heights, Stony Plain Central and High Park students will all need to be picked up at High Park School.
