 $\checkmark$  Complete the rest of the registration form. (Including your email address will ensure you receive reminder emails about hot lunch order deadlines, and your child's hot lunch order for the upcoming week)

 $\checkmark$  Click the "Register Now" button at the bottom

 $\checkmark$  Follow the instructions to add each child in your family who attends SPC. Once your child(ren) are registered, click on "Orders"

 $\checkmark$  Proceed to order hot lunch for your child(ren)

ALL orders and payments must be electronic.
