Principal's Message

With the second half of the school year started, we want to take time to thank everyone for your continued support of our students, staff and school. All of us at SPC value the important contributions that families make towards our students' success in school. One of the signs of a great school is the partnership between the school and families who work together for the best interest of all SPC students. Thank you to all families who were able to join us during our Parent Teacher Conferences last week, whether virtually, through a phone call, or inperson. If you were unable to attend, please do not hesitate to contact your child's teacher to discuss progress and areas that may require some growth as we begin the last five months of this school year.

One of our key focuses as a school is on student success in literacy. As we continue to use data to inform instruction, our focus this month will be on writing. All students in Grades 1-9 will be taking part in a writing assessment called the HLAT during regular class time at some point between Feb. 6-16. The HLAT is a consistent writing assessment used across the school to develop common writing practices and consistent language. It is a measure of individual student achievement in writing to inform instruction. The HLAT provides common evidence to build a continuum of writing and work towards high impact strategies to support students' areas of strength and growth.

February is also the month of our annual North Central Teachers' Convention. Many outstanding sessions are being offered and teachers will be attending the conference in-person this year on February 9th and 10th. As the month continues we invite students to wear Red, White or Pink on February 14th. February 22nd marks Pink Shirt Day and this year's theme is "Be Kind". We are grateful at SPC for the many ways that students, staff and our parent community find to lift each other up throughout the year.

On behalf of all of us here at SPC, we wish all of you a lovely Family Day weekend. As always, if you have any questions or concerns, I am only a phone call or email away.

REGISTRATION for 2023-2024

Tuesday, January 10, 2023 - Parkland School Division's annual online registration/verification process is coming soon. All Pre-Kindergarten to Grade 12 registrations for both new and returning students will be conducted online for the 2023-2024 school year.

Returning Parkland School Division Students

Returning PSD students will receive an email reminder to log into their <u>PowerSchool</u> Account and look for the RSVP button in the side navigation to launch the registration process.

New to PSD or Returning Evergreen and Private School Students Registering for Busing

Register online using the 2023-2024 New Online Registration Form if your student is not currently enrolled in a Parkland School Division school, or is registering for busing as an Evergreen Catholic or area private school student who uses PSD's Regional Transportation system. A link to the form will be posted in the Quick Links section of the website when registration opens on **Monday, February 13, 2023**.

During the registration process, it will be important to select the *2023-2024 School Year* to register for NEXT year. The option to register for 2022-2023 will remain for incoming students who wish to register for the balance of this current school year.

Registration Closes - March 24

All parents are required to complete the registration process by **4:30pm on Friday, March 24**, **2023**. This deadline allows us to determine the eligibility of bus pass applicants, the routing of buses, bus pass production and data verification before the summer break while schools are still operating.

Important Registration Dates

- **Monday, February 13, 2023** Registration opens. The New Student Registration Form for Evergreen Catholic, area private school students and new to PSD students will be added as a Quick Link on the homepage of psd.ca. Families of returning PSD students (i.e. students currently enrolled in a PSD school) complete the registration process starting in <u>PowerSchool</u>.
- Friday, March 24, 2023 at 4:30pm Registration deadline. For further information, visit our <u>Registration</u> page.
- Friday, June 23, 2023 Bus pass deadline to make payment arrangements or pay-in-full.
- Bus passes and route numbers will be mailed to parents starting at the beginning of July.

Please note: The 2022-2023 New Student Registration form is still open and accepting registrations for the current school year. **The 2022-2023 form cannot be used to register for 2023-2024**. When registering, please make sure to select the correct school year in the drop down menu for the field 'Select School Year'.

Complete information on the registration process can be found on our <u>Registration</u> page. More information regarding the 2023-2024 registration process will be added as it becomes available.
