Dear Christmas Hamper Champions,

For the 45th year, the Stony Plain Kinsmen are preparing for the Hamper community initiative for Stony Plain & West Parkland residents to help make Christmas brighter for local families struggling with a limited income. Our goal is to support local families in need with food and gifts over the holidays, and last year our community assisted 738 families in our area and supported over 2000 residents!

Your school community is so important in this social justice project. Many of the boys and girls who receive help are likely sitting right in your classrooms. No one needs to know who they are, it's enough to know that your friends and neighbours received a gift to open at Christmas. You make a difference!

As in years past, the Parkland Food Bank will administer the distribution of the food portion of the Christmas Hampers in the form of an 'upsized' December hamper for all clients. This year, the Kinsmen will also accept non-perishable food donations from schools only. Kinsmen volunteers will deliver food donations to the Parkland Food Bank. Additionally, we will continue to support the Parkland Food Bank with gift cards for food to contribute to the upsized December hamper. Last year, we provided over \$100,000 in grocery gift cards and meat certificates to hamper recipients! It's important that everyone has enough to eat and a little extra something special at Christmas.

The gift portion of the Christmas Hamper program will again run separately from the food. The Kinsmen will collect and distribute gifts and gift cards to all children 17 and under. Last year, you helped provide gifts for 920 children in our area!



Tooth decay is the most common, but preventable, childhood chronic disease both in Canada and around the world. Oral diseases frequently begin in the preschool years which is why it is so important to establish good oral hygiene behaviours as soon as possible.

The Government of Canada has implemented the Canada Dental Benefit, which is designed to provide some financial support to help Canadian families access dental care. With this benefit, families can start addressing some of the basic dental care that their young children need while the Government continues continues its work to develop a long-term Canadian dental care program.

#### **WHAT** is the benefit?

The Canada Dental Benefit provides up to \$650 per eligible child under 12 years. of age. You can apply for a maximum of 2 payments per child.

if the family's adjusted net income is under \$70,000

if the family's adjusted net income is be twe en \$70,000 and \$79,999

if the family's adjusted net income is between \$80,000 and \$89,999

The benefit can be used for any dental care provided by any regulated dental professional.



#### WHO can apply?

Parents/Guardians who:

- Have a child under 12 years of age, who does not have access to private dental care insurance.
- Have an adjusted family net income under \$90,000 per year.
- Have filed last year's income tax return-formore information on how to file a return, visit Canada.ca/doing-your-taxes.
- Receive the Canada Child Benefit for each eligible child.
- Have or will have out of pocket dental care expenses for each eligible child that have not been fully reimbursed under another federal, provincial or territorial government program.



#### **HOW** can you apply?

Canada Revenue Agency (CRA) My Account will be the quickest, easiest and most secure way to apply for the Canada Dental Benefit. If you don't have a CRA My Account, you can register at Canada.ca/ my-cra-account or call 1-800-715-8836.

You will need to provide information on the dental care visit, including the name of your child's dental care provider(s) and your employer information.

If you apply online and are signed up for CRA direct deposit, you can receive your payment within five business days!

Keep your child's dental receipts for six years in the event CRA contacts you to validate eligibility.

Make sure you have your Sodal Insurance Number, address, date of birth and a copy of your income tax return from last year.



#### WHEN can you apply?

Parents can now apply for the second benefit period, to help pay out-of-pocket expenses for dental care services received by their eligible child between July 1, 2023 to June 30, 2024.



#### WHAT if I don't read or speak **English or French?**

The application portal is only available in English and French. However, if you need help with the application, you can ask an English or French-speaking friend to sit with you while you fill out the application, or have them with you when you call 1-800-715-8836.

If you don't have a friend available to assist with the process, the CRA can arrange to call you back in order to have someone on the line who speaks your language.
